

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

TOWN OF GEORGINA – JANUARY 26, 2009

▶ Refusal of a Draft Plan of Subdivision

Council reviewed a refusal report, No. PB-2009-0005, regarding a draft plan of subdivision for lands described as Part of Lots 21 and 22, Concession 7(G) situated north of the Everglades Marina on the east side of the Pefferlaw River in Pefferlaw

▶ Approval to Amend the Official Plan and Zoning By-law

Council reviewed Report No. PB-2009-0006 in regard to an application to amend the Official Plan and Zoning By-law to permit the construction of a single family dwelling on lands described on Lot 75, Plan 472 at 12 Irving Drive, Pefferlaw

▶ Approval of Application to Deem Lots not to be lots on a Registered Plan of Subdivision

Council reviewed and approved Report No. PB-2009-0007 to deem Lots 37 and 38, Plan M-209 not to be lots on a registered Plan of Subdivision, 40 Evelyn Drive, Keswick

▶ School Crossing

Council approved a school crossing and guard at Lake Simcoe Public School and eliminated the school crossing guard at Keswick Public School

▶ Lake Simcoe Arts Foundation/Red Barn Theatre

Council granted an additional advance of \$10,000.00 from the 2009 operating budget and directed that the balance of \$20,000.00 grant be discussed at budget

▶ Jericho Youth Services

Council authorized staff to enter into negotiations for a lease agreement for the building located at 1964 Metro Road from January 1, 2009 to December 31, 2009

▶ Declaration

Council declared April 25, 2009 as 'World Malaria Day' in an effort to raise awareness of a largely preventable, treatable and curable disease

▶ Lake Simcoe Clean-Up Fund
