

## COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

### TOWN OF GEORGINA – FEBRUARY 23, 2009

- ▶ Sutton Agricultural Society  
Council received Report No. CAO-2009-0003 giving the Sutton Agricultural Society a grant in the form of a loan to be secured by a promissory note in the amount of up to \$40,000.00 and that the request be referred to the Economic Development Committee for consideration at the 2009 budget discussions
  
- ▶ Remuneration and Expenses of Members of Council and Local Boards  
Council received Report No. DAS-2009-0014 detailing the remuneration and expenses of Members of Council and appointees to local boards
  
- ▶ Draft Plan of Subdivision  
Council received Report No. PB-2009-0015 granting an extension to the draft Plan of Subdivision 19T-95070 located on the north side of Church Street in Keswick, to August 31, 2012 and approval shall lapse if final approval for registration has not been given by August 31, 2012 unless approval has been withdrawn or has been extended by the Town of Georgina
  
- ▶ 1<sup>st</sup> Pefferlaw Scouting  
-Councillor Hackenbrook will endeavour to attend the 1<sup>st</sup> Pefferlaw Scouting Appreciation Banquet being held on February 28, 2009 at the Pefferlaw Lions Community Hall
  
- ▶ Indigent Funerals in Ontario  
Council received Report No. DAS-2009-0015 requesting the Region of York to review rates for indigent funerals and assistance to cover funeral expenses for all needy individuals
  
- ▶ Application to Deem a lot not to be a lot on a Registered Plan of Subdivision  
Council received Report No. PB-2009-0017 and approved an application by Gordon Buch to deem Lot 40, Plan 306 not to be a lot on a Registered Plan of Subdivision

► Storm Drainage Outlet

Council received Report No. EPW-2009-0003 authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to execute a Deed/Transfer of Land to 2055226 Ontario Inc. respecting Part of Lots 280, 281 and 282, Part of Block D and part of George Road (unopened) on Registered Plan 427 for the purposes of a storm drainage easement and to provide compensation to the Town in an amount as 50% of the value of the lands subject

► Deputations

-Terry Zinck, President of the Georgina Minor Baseball Association, made a deputation to Council concerning the construction of a storage unit on the Civic Centre property which Council by Report No. LS-2009-0003 approved in principle

-Megan Keith on behalf of the Pefferlaw Association of Ratepayers, made a deputation to Council requesting the continuation of the mosquito abatement program for 2009 with the understanding that the issue will be discussed at the 2009 budget meeting

► Planning Matter

Council received Report No. PB-2009-0016 granting an extension to May 23, 2009, on an application to amend the Official Plan and Zoning By-law 500 to permit a go-kart track and indoor and outdoor paintball uses on land described as Part of Lot 1, Concession 2 (G). The extension is based on the understanding that none of the activities will take place until the matter has been resolved

► Communications

-Council received correspondence from the Clean Air Partnership concerning the GTA Clean Air Council
