### TOWN OF GEORGINA – MARCH 2, 2009

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▶ Council received Report No. LS-2009-0002 and approved revised Leisure Services Fees and Charges effective March 1, 2009.

▶ Council received Report No. LS-2009-0004 approving the ball diamond allocation policy and approved the ball diamond fees effective March 1, 2009

▶ Council received Report No. LS-2009-0005 on the Pefferlaw Ice Pad costs

▪ Council approved an application to deem Lots 18-19, Registered Plan 205, not to be lots on a Registered Plan of Subdivision

▪ Council approved an application to deem Lots 54 & 55, Registered Plan 124, not to be lots on a Registered Plan of Subdivision

▪ Council approved an application to deem Lots 158 & 159, Registered Plan 205, not to be lots on a Registered Plan of Subdivision

▪ Council received Report No. EPW-2009-0004 and passed a by-law to authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute a Subdivision Agreement between subdivision agreement, easement documents and land transfer documents made between Grangemuir Developments Inc., Camlane Holdings Inc. and Carness Developments Inc., as owners and the Corporation of the Town of Georgina respecting Stage 2 of Draft Plan of Subdivision No. 19TG-2003-001
