

## COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

TOWN OF GEORGINA – MARCH 23, 2009

### ► Reports

Council received Report No. LS-2009-0007 authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to enter into a lease agreement with the Lake Simcoe Soccer Club for a clubhouse facility

Council received Report No. EPW-2009-0009 authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to execute a subdivision agreement with Cheslock Developments (Keswick) Inc. regarding Plan 19T-04-G01

Council received Report No. EPW-2009-0010 assuming roadways within Phase II, III and IV of the Simcoe Landing Development

Council received Report No. LS-2009-0006 awarding the lighting of the Civic Centre Sportsfield Phase II to Wayne Electric Company Limited at a cost of \$120,800, the dismantling and removal of sportsfield fencing to Melfer Construction Inc. at a cost of \$4,200 and installation of outfield fencing on Diamond #12 to Melfer Construction Inc. at a cost of \$7,040

Council received Report No. EPW-2009-0008 on the initial program for collection of Agricultural Plastic Bale Wrap; greenhouse film to be added once operating experience has been gained and a need shown

Council received Report No. EPW-2009-0006 being the Summary Report, Schedule 22, Ontario Regulation 170/03, The Safe Drinking Water Act

Council received Report No. DAS-2009-0020 and awarded the supply and maintenance of photocopiers to Océ Canada at an annual lease of \$32,800 plus the associated copy contract

Council received Report DAS-2009-0022 adopting the 2009 Tax Levy Supported Budget

### ► Deputation

The president of the Lake Simcoe Soccer Club announced that the Town of Georgina is the successful nominee for the Ontario Soccer Association's "Corporate Centre Circle Award" for providing valuable service to the growth and development of soccer in Ontario

► Presentation

Council presented Victoria Cowan, Youth Poster Award recipient, and Monica Webster, Adult Poster Award recipient, with framed certificate and monetary gifts, for their submissions in the Georgina Equity and Diversity Advisory Committee Poster Contest

Neil MacDonald of the Region of York made a presentation to Council on the Blue Box Program Plan Review and Council passed a resolution receiving Report No. EPW-2009-0007 and stressing to the MOE the urgency of a more rapid movement to a full closed substance cycle waste management system, where the procedures are responsible for the total cost of both packaging and end product reclamation of all goods sold within the Province

► Actions

Council proclaimed May 13, 2009, as 'Steward of the Earth Day' and will provide a one-time contribution of \$1,000 towards the legal costs to become a viable not-for-profit organization

Council agreed to join the Coalition of Canadian Municipalities Against Racism and Discrimination

Staff was directed to bring the necessary amendments to the parking and zoning by-laws to a) change the width of parking spaces and to b) increase the number of disabled parking spaces in ratio to the total number of parking spaces required
