

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

TOWN OF GEORGINA – APRIL 14, 2009

► Reports

Council received Report No. EPW-2009-0011 authorizing Cheslock funding of \$94,632.00 be transferred to a reserve fund for future growth related road projects

Council received Report No. CAO-2009-0004 authorizing the Mayor and staff to make application for infrastructure funding for the Civic Centre Multi-Season Recreation Area

Council received Report No. DAS-2009-0018 granting exemption to Inland Iron & Metals from sections of the licensing and noise by-laws to allow 2 tractor trailers to be loaded on Sundays and Statutory Holidays for a one year period to April 24, 2010

Council received Report No. LS-2009-0008 approving the revised Pefferlaw Ice Pad Budget of \$1,018,000 and provide a contingency allowance of \$20,000.00

Council received Report No. PB-2009-0029 approving the 2008 Activity Report and proposed 2009 Action Plan for the Georgina Environmental Advisory Committee

Council approved Report No. PB-2009-0027 to permit a Day Nursery and an accessory Children's Indoor Play Studio on land described as Lots 32, 33, 34, & 35, Plan 408, Part 1, Plan 65R-15219.

Council approved Report No. PB-2009-0028, approving proposed OPA No. 103 and incorporating the proposed changes as outlined in section 4 of the report.

► Deputation

Council referred a request for consideration of a by-law to restrict smoking on Civic Centre Soccer Fields, to the Leisure Services Department to report back in cooperation with the Lake Simcoe Soccer Club, within the next few weeks.

► Actions

Council proclaimed Tuesday, April 28th, 2009, as 'Day of Mourning for Workers Killed or Injured on the Job'

Council approved 2009 Grant applications and Events Funding through the Economic and Tourism Development Division, to various organizations in the amount of \$14,500.00

Council referred correspondence from Environment Canada concerning a call for Letters of Intent for the Lake Simcoe Clean-Up Fund to the Director of Engineering and Public Works to update Council on the application process and a list of issues to be submitted for consideration

Council referred correspondence from the GEAC concerning the appointment of an Energy Conservation Officer for the Town, to the CAO to determine expectations for the position

Council approved reserve funding of \$20,000.00 for a consultant to complete a Family Health Team application for the Ministry of Health

The Georgina Community Health Care Committee is to appoint a Recruiting and Endowment Sub-Committee, which is to provide reports on its activities to the Georgina Community Health Care Committee monthly meetings.
