BY-LAW NUMBER 2011-0131 (TR-1)

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2002-0046 (TR-1) TO REGULATE TRAFFIC AND CONTROL THE PARKING OF VEHICLES IN THE TOWN OF GEORGINA

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Georgina deems it necessary to amend the Traffic and Parking By-law to accommodate parking enforcement changes in the Simcoe Landing Subdivision.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GEORGINA ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Section 1.0 DEFINITIONS be amended by adding the following:

(kk) "restricted vehicle" means a vehicle having attached thereto a truck or delivery body, buses, school buses, tractors used for hauling purposes, mobile homes, tow trucks, dump trucks, trucks with more than two (2) axles, recreational vehicles and trailers of any kind.

2. THAT a new section be added as follows:

3.8 RESTRICTED VEHICLES

No person shall park a restricted vehicle on any highway in the Simcoe Landing subdivision.

3. THAT Section 3.2 be amended as follows:

(a) No person shall park any vehicle on any highway:
(v) for a period longer than 3 hours
(Simcoe Landing subdivision exempt)

4. THAT the following streets be added to Schedule III NO PARKING, prohibiting parking on opposite sides of the streets on alternate days:

Bache Avenue, Bostock Drive, Brecken Drive, Brookhurst Avenue, Carness Crescent, Crittenden Drive, Glasgow Crescent, Grangemuir Drive, Havenwood Trail, Hirst Avenue, Ian Drive, Joe Dales Drive, Laurendale Avenue, Lundigan Drive, Paulgrave Avenue, Reddenhurst Crescent, Silverstone Crescent, Strathgreen Lane, Terrell

Avenue, Thornlodge Drive, Truscott Avenue &
Violet Avenue.
