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Georgina Town Council July 13

Work plan to review and update the Tree Preservation and Compensation Policy and initial research for a Town Tree Cutting By-law

Council received the report, and endorsed the work plan for a review and update of the Tree Preservation and Compensation Policy, and initial research for a Tree Cutting By-law. Staff will work with Procurement Services to hire a peer arborist consultant and begin the consultation program as set out in the work plan. Staff will also provide a report to Council on a Town Tree-Cutting By-law for the Sept. 14, 2022 Council meeting. It will provide results from in-depth research on other municipal approaches to tree protection and provide analyses of potential impacts to financial and staff resources of a Tree Cutting By-Law program.

Appointments to the Board of Management and approval of the annual 2022 budgets for the Sutton, Jackson's Point and Uptown Keswick Business Improvement Areas

Council received the report and approved the appointments to the board of management for the Sutton Business Improvement Area (BIA) and the Uptown Keswick BIA. Council also approved the 2022 annual budgets for the Uptown Keswick, Sutton and Jackson's Point BIAs. Only the Sutton BIA will be collecting a levy to support its activities. Commercially assessed property owners within the boundaries of the Sutton BIA boundary will receive an invoice and the BIA levy will be identified on the bill as a special charge.
