Boating safety

Georgina Fire and Rescue Services wants you to have a safe and fun boating season. Before heading out on the lake, complete a pre-departure checklist. Ensure you have all the required safety equipment on your boat and check to see if it's in working order. Boat smart. Boat sober. There is no safe way to mix alcohol or drugs and boating, and it is against the law. Always check the weather and wind conditions before you start your day on the water. Beaches and waterfront parks

Are you planning to visit one of Georgina's beaches and waterfront parks? There are a few things to remember. Barbeques or other cooking devices are not allowed on the beach or in the parks. Please don't litter and dispose of garbage in the waste receptacles. Parking lots are available to resident parking pass holders and visitors. A valid parking ticket from a pay-and-display machine must be displayed by visitors. By-law officers will be patrolling the area for illegally parked vehicles. Learn more at georgina.ca/beaches.

Bag tag program

Did you know? The Town has changed its bag tag program. Residents are now allowed to put up to two bags or containers/items out for pickup every other week on their regularly scheduled collection day. Any additional waste will require a bag tag. Bag tags are \$2 each and are available in groups of five for \$10. They can be purchased at the Civic Centre and all branches of Georgina Public Library. A list of retail distributors is available on the Town's website.

Large item fee

The Town has introduced a \$12 fee for large items such as furniture, mattresses, box springs, toilets, appliances and carpeting. Each large item will require its own large item orange tag and the maximum of five collectible items during the regular bi-weekly garbage collection schedule includes tagged large items. Residents are encouraged to recycle, as there is no limit on how many blue boxes or green bins that can be placed out each week. To learn more, visit georgina.ca/WasteandRecycling.



Resident parking pass

Residents and property owners can apply online and get a free parking pass immediately. Residents can obtain up to a maximum of four parking passes per household. Fire hydrant painting

Attention Georgina pooches! Some fire hydrants are undergoing a facelift throughout Town. About 800 fire hydrants, from Old Homestead Road to Ravenshoe Road in Keswick, are getting a new coat of paint. The work is being done in stages. The hydrants have to be stripped of the old paint and rust first, then primed and two coats of paint applied with drying between. The project should be complete by fall. So please look before you lift!
