Splash pads

Summer is here and the heat is on. Are you looking for a fun place to take the kids to cool off? Town splash pads are open. The Town has four splash pads – the ROC, Whipper Watson Park, Const. Garrett Styles Park and the newest splash pad at Julia Munro Park. They are open daily from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. Visit georgina.ca/SplashPads to learn more.

Bag tag program

Bag tags are available at retail locations throughout Georgina, as well as at the Civic Centre and all three branches of Georgina Public Library. Note that not all retailers sell the large item tags. Residents can put up to two bags or containers/items out for pickup every other week on their regularly scheduled collection day. Any additional waste will require a bag tag. Bag tags are \$2 each and are available in groups of five for \$10. A list of retail distributors is available on the Town's website.

Large item fee

The Town has introduced a \$12 fee for large items such as furniture, mattresses, box springs, toilets, appliances and carpeting. Each large item will require its own large item orange tag and the maximum of five collectible items during the regular bi-weekly garbage collection schedule includes tagged large items. Residents are encouraged to recycle, as there is no limit on how many blue boxes or green bins that can be placed out each week. To learn more, visit georgina.ca/WasteandRecycling.
