## Changes to the bag tag program starting next week

- Starting next week on July 4, residents will be able to place up to two bags or containers/ items out for pickup every other week on their regularly scheduled collection day. Any additional waste will require a bag tag.
- Bag tags are \$2 each and are available in groups of five for \$10. They can be
  purchased at the Civic Centre and all branches of Georgina Public Library. A list
  of retail distributors is available on the Town's website. Residents can put up to a
  maximum of five bags/items of garbage out, two free and three paid. Previously
  purchased bag tags will remain valid.
- The Town is introducing a \$12 fee for large items such as furniture, mattresses, box springs, toilets, appliances and carpeting. Each large item will require its own large item orange tag and the maximum of five collectible items during the regular bi-weekly garbage collection schedule includes tagged large items. Residents are encouraged to recycle, as there is no limit on how many blue boxes or green bins that can be placed out each week.

## Fire hydrant painting

Attention Georgina pooches! Some fire hydrants are undergoing a facelift throughout Town. About 800 fire hydrants, from Old Homestead Road to Ravenshoe Road in Keswick, are getting a new coat of paint. The work is being done in stages. The hydrants have to be stripped of the old paint and rust first, then primed and two coats of paint applied with drying between. The project should be complete by fall. #### **Fire and Rescue Services**

Georgina Fire and Rescue Services allow residents to have fires for a variety of reasons. Some require a permit. Residents can have a recreational fire as long as it is no larger than 2' x 2' and it must be at least 23' away from anything that can burn as well as property lines. A permit is not needed for a recreational fire. A permit is needed for openair burning.
