TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Georgina will be reviewing Council Procedure By-law at its meeting on September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022 commencing at 9:00 am. The intention of the review is to repeal and replace By-Law Number 2016-0014 (COU-2), “A By-Law to Govern the Calling, Place and Proceedings of Meetings for the Town of Georgina”, and By-Law Number 2020-0069 (COU-2), “A By-Law to Enact Electronic Meeting Procedures”. The purpose of the proposed review of the Procedure By-Law is to ensure it best supports the good governance of the municipality and aligns with provincial legislation.
