Land Subject to the Countryside Zoning By-law

Proposal: The Town of Georgina is updating Zoning By-law No. 500 to bring it into conformity with the policies, permitted uses and land use designations of the Town's Official Plan. The public meeting is to consider a proposed zoning by-law amendment (ZBA) that would delete the Countryside Area from Zoning By-law No. 500 and a zoning by-law that would establish a new Countryside Zoning By-law. An enabling official plan amendment (OPA) is also proposed that would amend Section 8.1.12 of the Official Plan to permit an additional residential unit in a detached building on the same lot as a single detached dwelling irrespective of whether the single detached dwelling contains an additional residential unit. A key map is provided below showing the Countryside Area. The proposed official plan amendment, zoning by-law amendment and zoning by-law are available for review at georgina.ca/ZoningBylawUpdate.
