Appointment of auditor for Audit Services

Council received the report regarding the appointment of an auditor for audit services. Council approved the recommendation to appoint KPMG LLP to provide audit services to the Town and its local boards and committees for the 2022, 2023 and 2024 fiscal years. Council also adopted a by-law. The Municipal Act requires Council appoint an auditor licensed under the Public Accounting Act to report on the annual financial statements of the municipality for Council.

Request for single source award to supply, deliver and install court equipment for the sports zone

Council received the report regarding the single-source award to supply, deliver and install court equipment for a new multi-purpose, outdoor sports zone on the Pefferlaw Ice Pad (PIP). Council approved the recommendation to award the contract to Court Surface Specialists Ltd. In April of this year, Council approved funding for the Pefferlaw Recreation Improvement Project, which includes construction of a skate and pump park, a new outdoor sports zone at the PIP, construction of a new community garden and other improvements.

Revised Procedure By-law

Council received the report regarding the revised Procedure By-law and adopted the by-law which will come into effect Nov. 15, 2022 with the new term of Council. The changes will enhance Council proceedings, align with changes within legislation as well as comply with the themes of openness, transparency and accountability.
