2022 Municipal Election

For the first time, the Town will use online voting, along with tabulators, for the 2022 Municipal Election. Online voting will be available from Oct. 8 to Oct. 23 at noon. Advance voting takes place on Oct. 8, 13, 15 and 19. All voters will receive a personalized Voter Information Letter in the mail prior to the start of the voting period. Truth and Reconciliation
