2022 Municipal Election

Voting in the 2022 Municipal Election is now open. The Town is using online voting, along with tabulators, for the election. Online voting is available until Sunday, Oct. 23 at noon. Advance in-person voting takes place on Oct. 13, 15 and 19. All voters will receive a personalized Voter Information Letter in the mail. The letter contains a Voting PIN (Personal Identification Number) along with the website to access the online ballot and information about in-person voting. All voting locations will be physically accessible throughout the election. Assistive voting devices are also available at select voting locations.
