## 2022 Municipal Election - Be sure to vote!

There are just a few more days to vote in the 2022 Municipal Election. The Town is using online voting, along with tabulators, for the election. Online voting is available until Sunday, Oct. 23 at noon. All voters should have received a personalized Voter Information Letter in the mail. It contains a Voting PIN (Personal Identification Number) along with the website to access the online ballot and information about in-person voting.



## Election Day – Oct. 24

The polls will be open from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. The Town offers a vote anywhere approach, meaning residents can vote at any of the vote locations.
