LICENSING APPEALS COMMITTEE

BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT MEMBERS TO THE GEORGINA
LICENSING APPEALS COMMITTEE FOR THE 2014-2018 TERM
OF OFFICE

WHEREAS Section 151 of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended (*Municipal Act*) provides the authority for Council to pass Business Licensing By-laws;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Georgina has passed By-laws to govern and regulate various business types and classes of businesses;

AND WHEREAS By-law 2002-0169, as amended, provides the authority to licence, apply terms and conditions to licences and the ability for applicants to appeal of decision of the Licensing Officer to cancel, suspension, apply terms and conditions and /or revoke business licences to the Licensing Appeals Committee;

AND WHEREAS the *Municipal Act* authorizes the Council of a municipality to employ such persons as are deemed necessary for the purposes of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Council deem it necessary to appoint members to a Licensing Appeals Committee for the Corporation of the Town of Georgina;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Georgina, in the Regional Municipality of York, hereby enacts as follows:

1. ADMINISTRATION

- 1.1** That the following persons be appointed as members of the Georgina Licensing Appeals Committee for the 2014-2018 term of office

- 1.2** That the above appointed members shall exercise all the authority, powers and rights of the LICENSING APPEALS COMMITTEE and shall perform all duties and obligations which by Act are or may be imposed upon the office in accordance with provincial legislation and policies, with the approved procedures of the Corporation of the Town of Georgina.

2. CONFLICTING LEGISLATION

- 2.1** If this By-law conflicts with the provisions of any Act, other than the *Municipal Act*, the provisions of the *Municipal Act* prevail to the extent of the conflict.

3. VALIDITY AND SEVERABILITY

- 3.1** It is hereby declared that notwithstanding any section, subsections, clause, paragraph or provision of the By-law or parts thereof, may be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unenforceable, illegal or beyond the powers of Council to enact, such section or sections or parts thereof shall be deemed to be severable and that all other sections or parts of this By-law are separate and independent therefrom and enacted as such as a whole. Same shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provisions of this By- Law or of the By-law as a whole.
- 3.2** Whenever any reference is made in this By-law to a statute of the Legislature of the Province of Ontario, such reference shall be deemed to include all subsequent amendments to such statute and all successor legislation to such statute.

4. SHORT TITLE

- 4.1** This By-law shall be cited as the LICENSING APPEALS COMMITTEE.


