## How to Find Zoning By-law Provisions for a Property

Zoning By-law No. 500 prescribes land use requirements for lands throughout the Town of Georgina. The full consolidated text, along with all zoning maps, can be found at:

- 1. How to find zoning provisions If you are looking to determine the zoning of a particular parcel of land and the requirements applying to its development or redevelopment, visit the above-noted link and follow these steps:
  - a. Go to <u>Schedule A Map 1</u> locate the property for which you seek zoning information and record the zone.
    - i. If you find a property is in an area that references Map 1a through Map 11, go to the appropriate <u>Schedule A Map</u>,
  - b. locate the property in question and:
    - i. identify the zone,
    - ii. go to the appropriate Section 6 through 28 and review the zoning provisions, and
    - iii. also review <u>Section 5 General Provisions All Zones</u>.
- 2. **More zoning information** <u>Once you have reviewed the zoning provisions</u> for the property, you may have additional questions. Also note that there may be Zoning By-law amendments for the property that may not be posted on-line. Please follow up by contacting the area Zoning Examiner:
  - For all properties located SOUTH of Old Homestead Road (Town-wide)

- the legal description,
- municipal address,
- current owner(s), or
- assessment roll number
