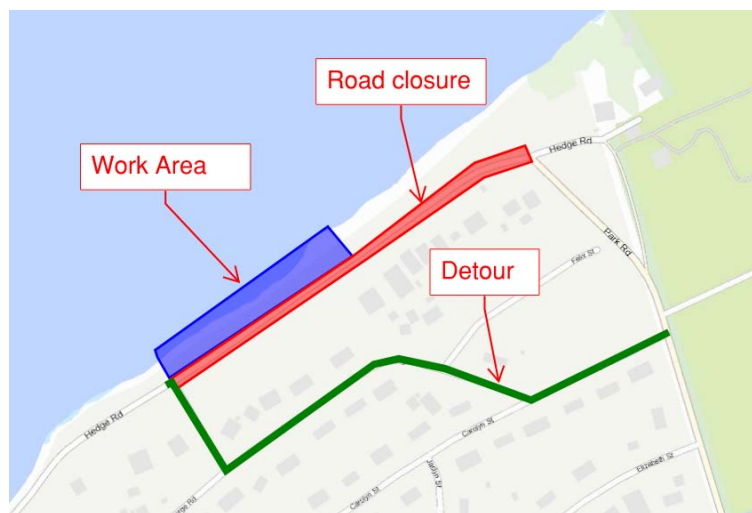
Notice to Residents Hedge Road Bank Stabilization – Road Closure and Tree Removal

Dear Resident(s),

The Hedge Road Bank Stabilization project is being undertaken by the Town of Georgina to restore the slope and reduce further erosion along the Lake Simcoe shoreline adjacent to Hedge Road. Early works for the first phase of the project extending from approximately Seaward Drive to 175 m east, will commence during the week of February 21, 2023. These early works include selective tree removals by the Town's retained tree works contractor.

Due to the Migratory Birds Convention Act tree removals must be completed before April 1 to protect the nesting habitat of birds. The subsequent work for bank restoration will begin in June/July and therefore the tree removals must be completed prior to the nesting season.

In order for the contractor to safely remove trees from the work area the road must be fully closed. The section of Hedge Road that will be closed is located between Seward Drive and Park Road as shown below. It is anticipated that the road will be closed for two (2) weeks. Local traffic will be able to access their driveways during the closure. Garbage pick-up will be arranged by the contractor.
