Verbal report – Multi-use Recreation Complex (MURC) update

Council received the [verbal update](#) on the status of construction of the MURC. All the building frame is up and the gym roof is complete. The siding, electrical and mechanical are progressing well. The basement stair has been installed and the pool mechanical is also progressing well. Preparation is underway for the concrete floor slab for the lobby and the pool. The project is more than half completed. The project is on time and on budget. The current schedule is targeting a Q4 2023 turnover to the Town to outfit with furniture and equipment. The target to open to the public is Q1 in 2024.

Proposed Subdivision Agreement, Treasure Hill Phase III Draft Plan of Subdivision 19T-20G01

Council received the report and adopted a by-law authorizing the Mayor and Town Clerk to execute the subdivision agreement, and authorized the Town solicitor to execute all easements, land transfers, road dedication of 0.3 metre reserves and other documents to be registered in connection with draft plan of subdivision 19T-20G01. Council approved amending traffic by-law 2002-0046 (TR-1) to regulate traffic and control the parking of vehicles in the Treasure Hill Phase III subdivision.

Summary of the 2023 budget for the Town of Georgina

Council received the report respecting the 2023 budget for the Town of Georgina. The report provides a summary of the budget that was approved by Council on Jan. 25, 2023. The 2023 budget includes a 4.89 per cent tax levy increase for the Town's operating budget and an additional capital contribution of 2 per cent to reduce the infrastructure funding gap and deliver on the capital projects in the 10-year capital plan, for a total tax levy increase of 6.89 per cent.
