Pefferlaw Pump Track and Skatepark

Construction has started on the new pump track and skatepark in Pefferlaw Park. It will be located southeast of the Pefferlaw Ice Pad and Sports Zone. The design includes features for users of all skill levels, including those who are new to the sport and people with disabilities. The flowing terrain provides an exciting user experience for skateboarders, bikes, scooters, roller bladers and sports wheelchairs. Users requested a larger pump track with a variety of riding options and directions. It will feature an expanded concrete skatepark and a junior loop off the main pump track.
