Georgina Fire and Rescue Services - Garage safety

The garage is beginning to become an extension of the home. Make sure yours is safe from fire. Always use a licensed electrical contractor to inspect and install additional circuits, outlets and to complete any repairs to your electrical system. Contact Electrical Safety Authority (ESA) for a licensed electrical contract near you.

Store gasoline in tightly capped, labelled and approved containers. The maximum quantity you can store is 30 litres. Do not store propane gas cylinders in your garage or home. Frequently dispose of flammable and combustible materials that are no longer needed or used.

Encourage smokers to smoke outside. Avoid emptying smoking materials directly into the garbage. Soak cigarette butts and ashes with water first and then discard into the garbage can. For more fire safety information, visit georgina.ca/fire.
