## **Georgina Town Council Oct. 25**

### Application for sign by-law relief for digital billboard at 2848 Ravenshoe Rd.

Council received the report regarding an application for sign by-law relief for a digital billboard at 2848 Ravenshoe Rd. and approved the application, pending the approval of the sign by the Ministry of Transportation and the removal of two billboards from 2354 Ravenshoe Rd. The two billboards to be removed are immediately north of the Ravenshoe Road and Woodbine Avenue intersection. Removing these two billboards will reduce the number of signs in the area.

## Pilot to provide Town staff and in-kind resources to support road closures within the Business Improvement Areas and historic downtowns

Council received the report regarding a pilot project to provide Town staff and in-kind resources to support road closures within the Business Improvement Areas (BIAs) and historic downtowns. Council approved a recommendation to assist the downtown Sutton Business Improvement Area with resources required to implement a closure of High Street on Nov. 25. 2023. Council directed staff to prepare a business case for the 2024 budget deliberations to request up to \$30,000 to support the provision of resources to support three road closures on a pilot basis for the BIAs and historic downtowns.

#### Addition of municipal street names to the Keswick Business Park

Council received the report regarding the addition of municipal street names to the Keswick Business Park and approved a recommendation that the assignment of Street Names Policy identify the Keswick Business Park as an area for which specific street names may be assigned. Council approved adding six new street names for inclusion into a category for the Keswick Business Park.
