Snowboard lessons

Riglet Park: Under 6 years old

Equipment provided. Lessons focus on variety of skills including donning equipment, proper stance, balance, pressure, rotation, how to ride around objects and more while being guided on a Riglet Reel snowboard. Parent must remain onsite. Lesson includes 15 mins for equipment fitting and 30 mins of instruction.

Mini Shredder 1: 3 to 6yrs



Introductory snowboard lessons are a great way to spend the winter and develop a passion for snowboarding at a young age. Participants, with the assistance of their parents/guardians, will learn the basics of snowboarding. Parent participation on foot is required.

Mini Shredder 2: 3 to 6yrs



For participants who are ready to ride independently. Participants will learn how to control their direction and speed with a focus on fun. Parent participation on foot is required.

Pre-requisite : Mini Shredders 1

Beginner Step 1: 7 to 17yrs

These lessons are for first-time riders! Participants will learn how to use the equipment, how to move around on flat ground, develop moving balance, develop confidence sliding with both feet attached to the board and also learn to control direction and speed.

Beginner Step 2: 7 to 17yrs

Lessons are for participants who want to refine their skills. Students focus on perfecting techniques such as moving balance, controlled carving, direction and speed.

Pre-requisite: Beginner Step 1 or some experience

Beginner Step 3: 7 to 17yrs

The lessons will focus on novice turns, how to traverse between turns, flexion/extension, and sliding 360's.

Pre-requisite: Beginner Step 1 and 2

Freestyle Step 1: 10-17yrs

Lessons are for experienced riders. Led by a qualified terrain park instructor, students will be introduced to terrain park riding, jumps, rails, and slope-style skill development. Available in group and private/semi-private format.

Pre-requisite: Beginner Step 3 or equivalent experience.

Ski lessons

Penguin: 3 to 6yrs



Lessons are for participants who are new to skiing. They will learn to glide with assistance, balance while walking on skis and have fun while skiing. Parent participation on foot is required.

Panda: 3 to 6yrs



These lessons are for participants who can glide with assistance (can make a pizza). They learn to maintain balance while gliding, maintaining a snowplow position and how to stop in a snowplow. Parent participation on foot is required.

Giraffe: 3 to 6yrs



Lessons are for participants who can glide without assistance. They will learn to control their speed in a snowplow, balance over both feet and stop by turning on both sides. Parent participation on foot is required.

Beginner Step 1: 7 to 17yrs

For participants who are new to skiing. They will learn how to use their equipment, execute turns, learn control, balance and increase their stability.

Beginner Step 2: 7 to 17yrs

Lessons are the next step for beginners wanting to improve their skills. Participants will learn how to ski in a parallel position, increase control, balance and increase their stability on steeper terrain. Skiers must be able to execute linked rhythmical snowplow turns. Previous ski lessons or experience recommended.

All prices are per person and subject to HST.

Parent participation on foot is required for all lessons with children ages 3-6yrs.

Parent is required to wear an all-access lift ticket (provided on day of lesson at no charge) and ski-industry approved helmet (bring your own or rent on-site).

Private



Private lessons are one-on-one instruction and are available for all ages and abilities. The lesson will focus on the riders' specific needs and goals.

Semi-private



All private lessons can be made into semi-private lessons upon request. To do so, register for the private lesson of choice and contact the ROC to register additional participants. It is recommended participants are of the same age (6yrs+) and ability.

Lesson requirements **Waitlists**

Participants must have the ability to put on and manage their own equipment or have a parent or guardian on-site to assist. All lessons will be 60 minutes in length (45 minutes for Riglet Park).

Participants must be wearing their season pass or lift ticket prior to beginning each lesson (participants can use their lift ticket one hour before or after their lesson - all-access tickets do not include tubing).

Parent participation on foot is required for all lessons with children ages 3-6yrs.

Parent is required to wear an all-access lift ticket (provided on day of lesson at no charge) and ski-industry approved helmet (bring your own or rent on-site).

Lesson arrivals and departures

Participants must arrive 15 minutes prior to lesson start time and meet instructor at their dedicated snow school flag.

Following the conclusion of each lesson accompanying adults will be required to pick up their child promptly at the designated exit area.

Waitlists are monitored on a regular basis and all efforts are put forward to create additional lessons. Participants will be contacted in priority sequence. Ensure all contact information is up-to-date at time of registration.

Equipment

All participants must wear ski-industry standard equipment (skis, ski poles, ski boots, snowboard, snowboard boots and helmet).

Participants can bring their own equipment or rent equipment. Rental equipment is available on-site (sizing availability is not guaranteed).

Assessments

Assessments are conducted on the first day of lessons to ensure each participant is registered in the correct level.

Note: Participants registered in the incorrect lesson may be required to transfer to a different lesson (subject to availability).

Inclement weather

Lessons run in a variety of weather conditions including rain, snow, wind and colder temperatures. Please ensure the participant is dressed appropriately for the current forecast. In the event of a closure due to unsafe conditions, participants will be notified by phone, email and/or text when possible to advise of the cancellation. Ensure all contact information is up-to-date at time of registration. All attempts will be made to reschedule missed lessons. If a lesson cannot be rescheduled a pro-rated credit will be provided.

Lesson cancellation policy

All lesson cancellation requests must be submitted in writing and sent directly to georginaroc@georgina.ca for consideration prior to the start time of the scheduled lesson.

Refer to the Town of Georgina's Program refund policy for more information at georgina.ca/programs.

Lessons cancelled by the Community Services Department will result in a pro-rated credit applied to account or a make-up class may be provided. Full refunds will be reviewed and issued upon request.

Keep passes/tickets visible

Participants and participating adults with a season pass must be wearing their pass for the duration of the lesson. Individuals who require an all-access pass will be provided one at the start of the lesson.
