Pickleball Participant Code of Conduct**

Town of Georgina strives to provide experiences that are welcoming, safe, inclusive, positive and respectful of all. This Code of Conduct identifies the standard of behaviour which is expected of all participants involved in any Town of Georgina pickleball programs.

- 1.1 Participants shall conduct themselves at all times in a manner consistent with the values of the Town of Georgina which includes fairness, integrity and mutual respect.
- 1.2 Participants shall at all times adhere to the Town's operational Policies and Procedures and to the Rules and Regulations provided by the Town of Georgina.
- 1.3 Participants shall avoid behaviours including but not limited to, misuse of alcohol or drugs, sexual harassment and/or violent behaviour that poses a direct threat to any other person in the facility.
- 1.3 Participants agree to treat one another with respect and play in an environment free from, including but not limited to, bullying, maltreatment, harassment, abusive or disrespectful language or actions, attempts to intimidate, profane language, inappropriate or obscene gestures, and racial or ethnic remarks and misconduct.

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action, including but not limited to, removal from the program, facility and/or termination of building use privileges. Any behaviour deemed unacceptable by Community Services Department will be addressed.
