2026 Municipal and School Board Elections

Notice to all municipal electors in the Town of Georgina

This notice is for anyone interested in being a candidate in the 2026 Municipal and School Board Elections on Oct. 26, 2026. Nominations for candidates seeking to run in the Town of Georgina's 2026 Municipal and School Board Election will be open from May 1, 2026, until Aug. 21, 2026, at 2 p.m.

Offices for which persons may be nominated are:

- **Mayor** – One (1) position to be elected at large
- **Regional Councillor** – One (1) position to be elected at large
- **Councillor** – Five (5) positions (one to be elected in each ward)
- **English Public School Trustee** – One (1) position to be elected
- **English Separate School Trustee** – One (1) position to be elected
- **French Public School Trustee** – One (1) position to be elected
- **French Separate School Trustee** – One (1) position to be elected

Nominations for the positions listed must be filed on the prescribed form (Form 1) either in person or by your agent, with the Returning Officer or designate between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. from May 1 to Aug. 20, 2026, and between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. on Aug. 21, 2026 (Nomination Day).

Make an appointment with the Clerk's Division to file your nomination. Appointments can be arranged by emailing votes@georgina.ca or calling 905-476-4301.

Each nomination form must be accompanied by the endorsement of nomination form (Form 2) signed by at least 25 people (School Board candidates are exempt) along with the required fee. The required filing fee for the Head of Council is \$200 and all other offices are \$100 (cash, debit, or certified cheque made payable to the Town of Georgina).

Candidates must not spend or raise any funds for their election campaign until the registration/nomination form has been filed.

For School Board Trustee nominations, candidates must file their nomination papers with the Municipal Clerk of the designated municipality for the applicable school board.
