Date

Wednesday July 22, 2026, 5 p.m. to 8 p.m.

Wednesday Aug. 19, 2026. 5 p.m. to 8 p.m.

Cost

\$40 + HST for each day + insurance

Insurance

\$22.05 + HST for non-food vendors

\$28.35 + HST for beverage vendors

\$35.70 + HST for food/beverage vendors

If a vendor carries their own insurance, they will be required to provide a copy of their Certificate of insurance (COI) in the amount of \$2M listing the Town of Georgina as an additional insured.

Food and beverage vendors

All food and beverage vendors must also fill out the York Region Vendor Application form for special events. The MURC is not responsible to send this on your behalf.

Market day

Vendors will be expected to be on-site at the MURC by 4 p.m. to set-up and remain until 8 p.m. and always maintain coverage of their tables. You will be given a space to fit a six-foot rectangular table that you will supply. If you do not have access to a table, contact the MURC and one can be supplied if available. All break down and clean up is the responsibility of the vendor.

All items or ingredients prepared outside of the MURC Summer Pop-Up Market, considered “potentially hazardous foods” by York Region Public Health, must be prepared in an inspected kitchen. Rules and regulations

Location

The MURC 261 Garrett Styler Dr., Keswick (indoors, outdoors)

Eligible vendors

Hand crafters, artisans, farmers, artists, bakers, chefs, gardeners and décor. First preference will be given to vendors from the Georgina community followed by vendors from the greater York Region area.

Application deadline

Vendor applications must be completed and returned on or before Thursday July 9, 2026.

Vendor responsibilities

All Food and beverage and farm vendors must fill out and submit to York Region 'the York Region Vendor Application Form for Special Events' (see attached). A copy of the York Region Vendor Application form must be attached with this application. The MURC Summer Pop-Up Market is not responsible to submit these forms to York Region Public Health on your behalf.

No produce will come directly or indirectly from the Ontario Food Terminal.

Compliance with both provincial and federal sales tax regulations are the responsibility of the individual vendor.

No person shall sell or offer for sale food that does not conform to the Public Health Act and all regulations made thereunder. The Special Events Programmer will conduct inspections at random or as required. The Special Events Programmer has the right to request food items be removed if in violation of standards provided by York Region Community and Health Services.

Vendors agree to accept full responsibility for any loss, damage or accident occurring at the MURC Summer Pop-Up Market as a result of negligence or willful default on the part of the vendor.

Vendors will be required to provide a Certificate of Insurance (COI) in the amount of \$2M listing the Town of Georgina as an additional insured that covers all the dates you wish to participate in or, purchase it from the Town at a cost of \$35.70 plus HST for a food/drink vendor, \$28.35 plus HST for beverage vendors and \$22.05 plus HST for non-food vendors.

All vendors are responsible for compliance with health regulations.

All vendors shall label their products clearly by type and price.

All vendors agree to practice friendly customer service and not to engage in distress pricing.

Vendors are responsible for always keeping their table area neat and clean. At the end of the event, the vendor is required to remove everything from his/her space and floor area.

Vendors are responsible for bringing their own tables and any other necessary display material.

Subletting of tables is not permitted, except for a member of the immediate family, and in that case, with the approval of the Special Events Programmer.

The Special Events Programmer has the right to move vendors to any location within the MURC Summer Pop-Up Market area.

All vendors are responsible for notifying the Special Events Programmer, in writing and one week in advance of the event, if they are unable to attend.

Vendors are responsible for obtaining all permits required in the production and sale of their goods.

Set up

Vendors must arrive to the MURC by 4 p.m. and ensure they are ready to sell by 5 p.m.

Vendors must stay within the boundaries of their table.

The Special Events Programmer shall have the right to approve any signs, decorations or displays in the vendor's space and/or request changes or removals if necessary.

No vendor shall make any changes or alteration to Town property.

No signs or other material shall be affixed to any walls inside the MURC.

Vendors shall remain in their own market space when selling. Sales shall be conducted in an orderly manner.

Vendor tables must be attended to at all times through to the end of the market day (8 p.m.) by a responsible person. No objectionable means of soliciting shall be permitted.

The Town of Georgina cannot be held responsible for items destroyed by fire, vandalism, theft or any other cause.

Vendors shall not block walkways or fire exits or other vendors' tables.

Origin of products

Vendors shall only sell those items which are approved by the Special Events Programmer.

Only Ontario grown produce or meat may be sold.

Products coming directly or indirectly from the Food Terminal are not permitted.

All craft products must be new and not factory made or commercially produced.

Flea market or manufactured items are not permitted.

All produce, plants, flowers and meats must be produced, grown and processed in Ontario within 200 km of Georgina.

Penalties

Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these rules and regulations is subject to the cancellation of their table space at the MURC Summer Pop-Up Market and no refund.
