Georgina COVID-19 vaccination clinic

The York Region COVID-19 vaccination clinic located at the Georgina Ice Palace, 90 Wexford Dr., will be closing on August 22. Rather than operating these mass COVID-19 vaccination clinics, York Region Public Health is beginning to transition to smaller mobile and pop-up clinic models.

Until August 22, the clinic will accept walk-ins for both first and second doses for all eligible individuals who live, work or go to school in York Region. Beaches and waterfront parks

Georgina's beaches and waterfront parks are open. Town staff are on site to monitor and control the number of users. Please remember – barbecues or other cooking devices are not allowed on the beach or in the parks. Visit georgina.ca/beaches for more information. Parking lots are available to both resident parking pass holders and non-residents. As of July 1, residents must have a 2021 resident parking pass to park for free in the resident parking lot. For those without a pass, pay-and-display machines are operating. To apply for a parking pass visit georgina.ca/ParkingPass. Georgina residents can get a 2021 parking pass on site at De La Salle Beach, Holmes Point and Willow Beach, from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. daily. Residents will need to show their driver's licence, or proof of residency, and provide their licence plate number. Only one parking pass will be issued per vehicle on site.
