Georgina COVID-19 vaccination clinic

The York Region COVID-19 vaccination clinic, located at the Georgina Ice Palace, 90 Wexford Dr., will be closing on Aug. 22. York Region Public Health is transitioning to smaller mobile and pop-up clinics. Until Aug. 22, the clinic will accept walk-ins for both first and second doses for all eligible individuals who live, work or go to school in York Region.
