## Beaches and waterfront parks

Georgina's beaches and waterfront parks are open with restrictions. Town staff are on site to monitor. Visit [georgina.ca/beaches](http://georgina.ca/beaches) for more information. Parking lots are available to resident parking pass holders and non-residents. As of July 1, residents must have a 2021 resident parking pass to park for free. To apply for a parking pass, visit [georgina.ca/ParkingPass](http://georgina.ca/ParkingPass). Georgina residents can get a 2021 parking pass on site at De La Salle Beach, Holmes Point and Willow Beach, from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. daily. Residents will need to show their driver's licence, or proof of residency, and provide their licence plate number. Only one parking pass will be issued per vehicle on site.

## Community cleanup

Pitch-In Week is usually held in the spring. It was missed this year due to the stay-at-home order. The Town is now holding it the week of July 19 to 23. Residents can pick up bags and gloves at the Civic Centre starting Monday, July 12 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the front door, while supplies last. Once you have completed a cleanup in your area, advise Customer Service by calling 905-476-4301 and pickup will be arranged.



## Outdoor recreation programs

The Town is now offering outdoor recreation programs for the entire family such as Yoga, Zumba, canoe/kayak and the Kids Park programs. The kids park programs are workshop style and include classic camp games, adventures, challenges, and arts and crafts. ## Water meter replacement Starting week of July 12

A water meter replacement program is taking place in south Keswick starting the week of July 12. The approximately 300 affected homes will be notified by the Town. These meters have reached the end of their lifecycle and a mandatory replacement is required. The Town is working with Neptune Technology Group to complete the replacements and these staff will be carrying photo ID badges.
