Beaches and waterfront parks

Georgina's beaches and waterfront parks are open. Town staff are on site to monitor and control the number of users. Please remember – barbecues or other cooking devices are not allowed on the beach or in the parks. Visit georgina.ca/beaches for more information. Parking lots are available to both resident parking pass holders and non-residents. As of July 1, residents must have a 2021 resident

parking pass to park for free in the resident parking lot. For those without a pass, pay-and-display machines are operating. To apply for a parking pass visit georgina.ca/ParkingPass. Georgina residents can get a 2021 parking pass on site at De La Salle Beach, Holmes Point and Willow Beach, from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. daily. Residents will need to show their driver's licence, or proof of residency, and provide their licence plate number. Only one parking pass will be issued per vehicle on site.
