Beaches and waterfront parks

Georgina's beaches and waterfront parks are open. Town staff are on site to monitor and control the number of users. Parking lots are available to both resident parking pass holders and non-residents. As of July 1, residents must have a 2021 resident parking pass to park for free in the resident parking lot. For those without a pass, pay-anddisplay machines are operating. To apply for a parking pass visit georgina.ca/ParkingPass. Georgina residents can get a 2021 parking pass on site at De La Salle Beach, Holmes Point and Willow Beach, from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. daily. Residents will need to show their driver's licence, or proof of residency, and provide their licence plate number. Only one parking pass will be issued per vehicle on site.
