Official opening of Pefferlaw Fire Hall

The Town of Georgina marked the official opening of the new Pefferlaw Fire Hall on Nov. 6. Fire Station 1-8 is a welcome addition to Pefferlaw's downtown that also embraces the heritage of the community by incorporating the former Cooke's United Church.

At more than 8,000 square feet, the new fire hall includes a number of features:

- Three double-depth apparatus bays that can accommodate vehicles 40 feet in length
- · Gear room
- · Office space
- Full kitchen
- · Fitness room
- Workshop/repair room
- Training/education room that can accommodate 20 people for training purposes

Carbon monoxide is a byproduct of incomplete combustion of fuels such as natural gas, propane, heating oil, kerosene, coal, charcoal, gasoline or wood. The perfect time to change the batteries in your smoke and CO alarms is when you change your clocks. Also, test your alarms monthly by pressing the devices test button. Winter restrictions reminder

Residents of the Town of Georgina are reminded that Municipal By-laws prohibit any person from:

 Parking on any highway under the authority of the Town from Nov. 15 through April 15

- between the hours of 2 a.m. and 7 a.m.*
- Parking over any portion of a sidewalk or footpath (year-round)
- Parking on the boulevard section of the driveway with vehicle overhanging any portion of the roadway (year- round)
- Parking for a period in excess of three hours except where signs indicate a lesser period (year-round)*
- Depositing snow or ice on a highway, sidewalk or untravelled portion of a highway
- Parking during a declared Winter
 Maintenance Event requires all parked
 vehicles to be removed from Town roads
 immediately and kept off the roadway until
 the declaration has been rescinded.

Leisure vehicle storage

As of Oct. 31, residents are reminded seasonal storage of summer leisure vehicles on residential lots is not permitted. Snowmobiles or similar winter vehicles may be stored seasonally for the period of Nov. 1 until March 31. Permanent storage of leisure vehicles may be allowed on residential lots that meet the requirements and setbacks provided in the regulations. For more, visit georgina.ca/LeisureVehicles.

Public water taps

Residents can obtain their individual access keys to the public water tap at Black River Road and Park Road by visiting the Environmental Services Yard at 26817 Civic Centre Rd. from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday to Friday. A refundable deposit of \$20 (cash or cheque only) is required to obtain an access key. Water taps at the other locations have been closed due to concerns related to potential backflow and contamination from commercial users who are not permitted to use them. A more permanent solution to upgrade and replace the public taps

is being developed. The tap at Black River Road and Park Road has been retrofitted with appropriate backflow prevention to protect the water system. Larger volumes of water may be purchased from the Town's Bulk Water-filling station located at the Environmental Services Yard. Questions regarding access keys can be directed to 905-476-2445. Sewer flushing

The Water Division has started the annual sewer maintenance in order to prevent blockages and sewer backups. Sewer flushing is taking place in south Keswick between Ravenshoe Road and Old Homestead, and in Sutton on River Street, High Street and West Street this fall. The crew is taking every precaution possible to avoid any inconvenience but occasional toilet splashes may occur in locations with deficient plumbing. Ensure toilet lids are kept closed when not in use. The cleaning of sewer pipes is a standard practice throughout all municipalities. Cleaning sewer lines is essential to maintaining a properly functioning sewer system and ensuring the community's investment in its wastewater infrastructure is maintained. This activity removes grit, sand and gravel from sewer piping to prevent blockages, odour generation and premature wear of mechanical components in the sewer lift stations.

On rare occasions, some households will experience small spills, noises and odours. This can occur where there is a plumbing issue at the private residence. The most common reasons for this is inadequate venting and other non-compliant plumbing code arrangements. If an occurrence is determined to have happened as a result of the reasons noted above, it is suggested a plumber be contacted to identify the problem.
