## Winter restrictions reminder

Residents of the Town of Georgina are reminded that Municipal By-laws prohibit any person from:

- Parking on any highway under the authority of the Town from Nov. 15 through April 15 between the hours of 2 a.m. and 7 a.m. - unless otherwise posted
- Parking over any portion of a sidewalk or footpath (year-round)
- Parking on the boulevard section of the driveway with vehicle overhanging any portion of the roadway (year-round)
- Parking for a period in excess of three hours except where signs indicate a lesser period (year-round)

- Depositing snow or ice on a highway, sidewalk or untravelled portion of a highway
- Parking during a declared Winter Maintenance Event requires all parked vehicles to be removed from Town roads immediately and kept off the roadway until the declaration has been rescinded

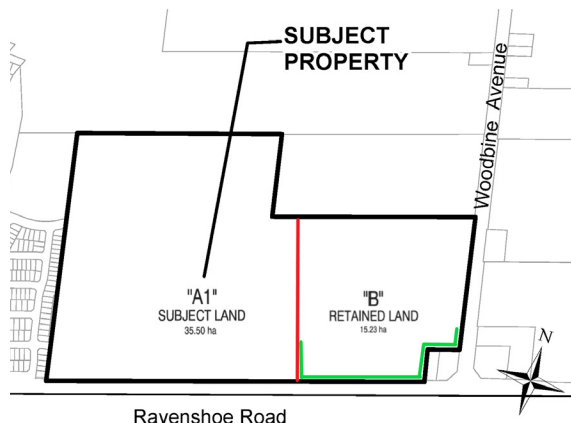
