Public water taps

The Town is closing three of its four public water taps effective the week of Oct. 18. The taps are being closed due to concerns related to potential backflow and contamination. One public tap, located at Black River and Park Road, will be left open. The Town also owns and operates one bulk water-filling station for commercial vehicles (tankers). It is located at the Environmental Services yard on Civic Centre Road, and allows for automated, 24-hour access to potable water. Commercial users are required to purchase this water through a pay-for-use system accessed with a pre-paid PIN number card.
