Members of the public are welcome to tour the facility beginning at noon. Tours will be in 30-minute time slots. COVID-19 protocols will be in place including the wearing of masks and proof of vaccination.

Public water taps

Residents can obtain their individual access keys to the public water tap at Black River Road and Park Road by visiting the Environmental Services Yard at 26817 Civic Centre Rd. from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday to Friday. A refundable deposit of \$20 (cash or cheque only) is required to obtain an access key. Water taps at the other locations have been closed due to concerns related to potential backflow and contamination from commercial users who are not permitted to use them. A more permanent solution to upgrade and replace the public taps is being developed. The tap at Black River Road and Park Road has been retrofitted with appropriate backflow prevention to protect the water system. Larger volumes of water may be purchased from the Town's Bulk Water-filling station located at the Environmental Services Yard. Questions regarding access keys can be directed to 905-476-2445. Public Information Centre Hedge Road Bank Restoration

The Town is completing a project related to slope and bank restoration along Hedge Road from approximately 100 metres west of Dunkirk Avenue to 150 metres east of Seaward Drive. The goal of the project is to identify areas requiring bank stabilization, and complete the required construction works to protect the road. A Public Information Centre (PIC) is being held where residents can learn more about the project, ask questions and share comments.

Registration is open.





An Official Plan Amendment application has been submitted by MLS Planning Consulting on behalf of Margaret Gallina to facilitate a consent to divide the subject property into two residential building lots.

The property is designated 'Serviced Lakeshore Residential Area' in the Official Plan. An Official Plan Amendment application is required as the proposed severance does not conform to Section 11.4.2.8(e) of the Official Plan, which provides the minimum lot frontage and area requirements in the 'Serviced Lakeshore Residential Area' designation.
