Did you know the Town is working on a Waterfront Parks Master Plan? We've received a lot of great feedback and are reaching out again to find out what you think of the updated design concepts.

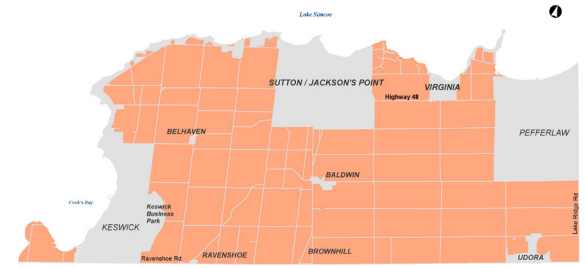
Virtual consultation:

Notice of project initiation Town of Georgina Zoning By-law Update - Phase 1

Proposal: In accordance with Section 26(9) of the Planning Act, the Town is undertaking the mandatory exercise of updating Zoning By-law No. 500 to bring it into conformity with the policies, permitted uses and land use designations of the Town Official Plan. Zoning by-laws regulate the types of permitted land uses and the character, height, location, size and massing of buildings for all lands in the Town. Compliance with the zoning by-law is required in order to receive a building permit for any proposed construction.

Study Area: The Phase I study area includes all lands within the rural countryside area of the Town as shown in the key map below. Lands within Secondary Plans, Hamlets and the Lakeshore Residential Areas are not included in the Phase I study area.
