2022 Municipal Election

The Municipal Election will be held on Oct. 24, 2022. For the first time, the Town will use online voting, along with tabulators, for the election.

Are you thinking about becoming a candidate? The nomination period for candidates opens on May 2, 2022 and closes on Aug. 19, 2022 at 2 p.m. Information and nomination forms can be found at georgina.ca/Election2022.

Notice of nomination for office 2022 Municipal Election

Municipal Elections occur every four years in Ontario and are governed by the Municipal Elections Act.

The next regular Municipal Election to elect a Mayor, Regional Councillor, Five Ward Councillors, and School Board Trustees is on Oct. 24, 2022. The new term of Council begins Nov. 15, 2022 and ends after the municipal election in 2026.

The nomination period for candidates opens on Monday, May 2, 2022. Nominations may be filed in person or by agent during regular business hours, with the Town's Clerks Division on or after May 2, 2022 to Aug. 18, 2022 and on Friday, Aug. 19, 2022 (Nomination Day) between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m.

Nominations must be submitted on the prescribed form and must be accompanied by endorsement signatures from 25 eligible electors, be signed by the candidate and be accompanied by the prescribed nomination filing fee (\$200 – Mayor and \$100 – all other positions). The prescribed forms are available online or by contacting the Clerks Division. Appointments are encouraged and can be arranged by emailing clerks@georgina.ca. Street sweeping

Spring street sweeping operations take place each spring to remove winter sand from Town roads. Weather permitting, street sweeping occurs weekdays from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. If you have sand on your driveway or sidewalk, sweep it to the edge of the road for removal by the street sweeper. Residents can obtain up to a maximum of four parking passes per household. A parking pass must be displayed on your dashboard while parked in areas where required by signage.
