Parking restriction reminders

Did you know that parked cars on Town streets and sidewalks make plowing difficult? Avoid parking on the street or over a sidewalk after a snowfall. Winter parking restrictions are in effect until April 15, meaning no parking on most streets between the hours of 2 a.m. and 7 a.m. For more information, visit georgina.ca/parking.



Stormwater Pond Safety

Colder temperatures mean stormwater ponds are freezing over. This is a reminder they are not to be used for skating. Stormwater ponds are not intended or designed for recreational use as water levels can change rapidly and create unsafe conditions. COVID-19 update

The Town is now in the modified step 2 of the province's Roadmap to Reopen. The province has reintroduced public health and workplace safety measures in response to the rapidly spreading COVID-19 variant, Omicron. All Town indoor sport and recreation facilities are now closed to the public, and all indoor in-person programming has been cancelled. Anyone impacted by cancelled programs and third-party rentals will be contacted directly. Each of the three library branches has moved to curbside pickup service. GO-VAXX bus in Pefferlaw

The GO-VAXX bus will be in Pefferlaw on Saturday, Jan. 15 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Pefferlaw Lions Hall, 38 Pete's Lane. COVID-19 vaccines will be available by appointment only. The ROC

The ROC is open for the season. Two-hour tickets must be purchased online in order to visit. Season pass holders will not be required to reserve tickets online, however, all attendees (including season pass holders) will be required to check in at the outdoor ticket office window upon arrival. Capacity is reduced and masks must be worn at all times. The chalet is open for washroom use and there is a limited cafeteria takeout service only. Pefferlaw Ice Pad

The Pefferlaw Ice Pad (PIP) is open for the season. Registration is not required and there is no admission charge. COVID-19 procedures and protocols are in place. Masks must be worn when physical distancing cannot be maintained such as lacing up in the skate area. Visit georgina.ca/skating for more information.



Winter maintenance event and significant weather event

The Town is committed to providing a consistent level of snow removal service throughout the winter season. Using a combination of Town staff and contractors, plowing, sanding and salting is performed each winter with consideration to safety, environmental and budgetary concerns.

Winter Maintenance Event: During a significant winter storm, the Town may declare a Winter Maintenance Event and a Significant Weather Event that will require all parked vehicles be removed from Town roads until the storm event ends, the Town has completed snow removal, sanding and salting operations, and the declaration is lifted.

Significant Weather Event: As per the Ontario Municipal Act, a municipality may declare a significant weather event when a weather hazard, either forecast or occurring, has the potential to pose a significant danger to users of the roadways in which they have authority. This declaration suspends the standard timelines required for municipalities to meet their winter maintenance objectives.

With winter weather here, Georgina Fire and Emergency Services is reminding residents to be a hydrant hero and keep fire hydrants three feet clear of ice and snow in every direction. In a fire emergency every second counts. You can help by keeping the fire hydrant closest to your house clear of snow so we can connect to it if needed. Also, to protect you and your family, take a walk around the outside of your home and make sure the intake and exhaust vents for furnaces and heating appliances are free of ice, snow, debris. 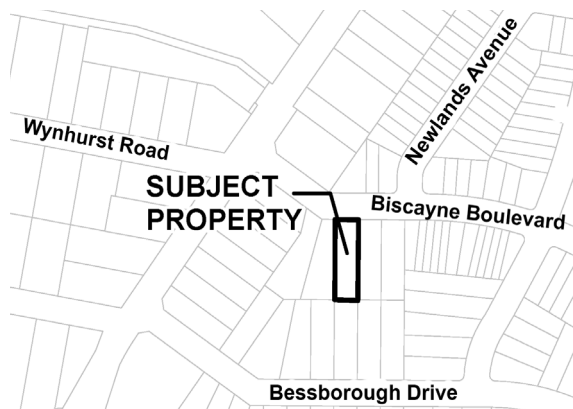

A Zoning By-law amendment application has been submitted by Michael Smith Planning Consultants; Development Coordinators Ltd; on behalf of Domenic Sorbara and Eugenio Sturino to rezone the subject property from 'Low Density Urban Residential (R1)' to 'site-specific Low-density Urban Residential (R2-XX)'. The

purpose of the application is to facilitate the construction of two semi-detached dwellings. Land division along the future common wall is proposed to occur at a later date.

When you are confirmed as a registered speaker, you will be provided with codes and instructions to participate in the electronic Council meeting. Any person may attend the meeting and/or
