Proposal: A Zoning By-law amendment application has been submitted by Michael Smith Planning Consultants; Development Coordinators Ltd; on behalf of Greg and Amanda Moore to rezone the subject properties from 'Rural' (RU) to 'site-specific Residential'

(R-XX) and 'site-specific Open Space' (OS-YY). The purpose of the application is to facilitate the construction of single family dwelling, swimming pool and cabana. A concurrent Deeming By-law application has been made that, if approved and registered, would allow for the merging of the subject properties on title.
