Parking passes

The Town of Georgina has introduced a new online process for resident parking passes. Residents and property owners can now apply online and get a parking pass immediately. The process is easy. Visit the Town's online permitting and parking pass portal, and sign up for an account. Once in the portal, residents can complete the form and a permit will be emailed immediately once approved. Step-by-step instructions are available on the Town website. Residents can obtain up to a maximum of four parking passes per household. 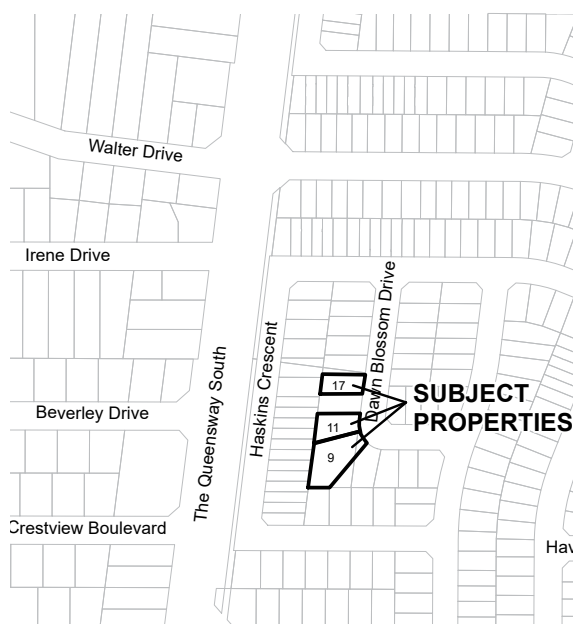
