## 2022 Municipal Election

## New! Changes to bag tag program

- Starting July 4, 2022, the Town of Georgina will implement changes to its Bag Tag program.
- Residents will be able to place up to two bags or containers/items out for pickup every other week on their regularly scheduled collection days and any additional waste will require a bag tag.
  - Bag tags are now \$2 each and will be sold in groups of five for \$10. They will be available at the Civic Centre and all branches of Georgina Public Library. A list of participating retail distributors will be available on the Town's website. Residents can put up to a maximum of five bags/items of garbage out, two free and three paid.
  - The Town is introducing a \$12 fee for large items such as furniture, mattresses, box springs, toilets, appliances and carpeting. Each large item will require its own large item orange tag and the maximum of five collectible items during the regular bi-weekly garbage collection schedule includes tagged large items. Residents are encouraged to recycle, as there is no limit on how many blue boxes or green bins that can be placed out each week.
