Celebrate Canada Day at the ROC

Georgina, ON – Summer is almost here and that means it's time to celebrate Canada Day. The Town of Georgina's event takes place Friday, July 1 at the ROC from 2 p.m. to 10 p.m., ending with a fireworks finale. It will be a fun day full of exciting festivities for the whole family. Enjoy live entertainment, children's activities, inflatables, food and more. Online services

Residents are reminded of the many online services available and that can be accessed from the comfort of home. The Town has added additional functions and features to the website so residents can access service at their convenience. Visitors to [georgina.ca/OnlineServices](https://www.georgina.ca/OnlineServices) can register for programs, pay a bill or ticket, obtain a parking pass or apply for various permits.

Fireworks

Residents are reminded they are only allowed to set off fireworks without a licence on Victoria Day and Canada Day, as well as the day before and after each of these holidays. To set off fireworks on any other day, a licence is required. Licences can be picked up at the Civic Centre or by calling 905-476-4301 to request an emailed application. Applications must be submitted in person. There is a \$25 fee.

Fires

Residents planning a fire over the long weekend are reminded that permit applications for agricultural and open-air burn permits are available online. The permit fee is \$35 for the calendar year.
