The Committee was advised there was nothing YRP could do about unsafe pedestrians and cyclists; but that YRP would be moving forward with a new initiative to catch motorists, which would involve taking the 'radar' on the YRP bicycles. The Committee was advised that the Town has been made aware of the concerns that had been sent to YRP.

Scott Edwards, Road Superintendent, reported to the Committee that there are two students currently working on the tracker. The students will work on keeping the tracker up to date. The students will also make changes at the Committee's request with respect to layout and format. Scott Edwards explained the current layout and design of the tracker that is being used as he updated the Committee on current outstanding inquiries.

The Committee discussed various locations of concerns noted on the tracker including Hedge Rd. and Old Shiloh Rd.

The Committee discussed creative solutions for speeding such as painting to make lanes narrow. Committee members also discussed how perception can be influenced by terrain (bends or hills on the road were used as an example).

11. OTHER BUSINESS

- (1) Discussion – ticketing for traffic violations (speeding) on unassumed roads.

Committee member Sgt. Sarah Riddell advised that Section 128 of the Highway Traffic Act (HTA) does allow for ticketing in construction areas (regarding unsummed developed areas). If there is no signage, it is assumed the speed is 50 km/hr under the HTA. Designated construction zones can have reduced speeds under the HTA (there should be a start and end to zone posted). Sgt. Riddell clarified that construction vehicles are also required to comply with the speeds posted in the safety zones.

- (2) Committee members to select a new area of interest for further investigation (ongoing agenda item).

The Committee suggested John Link be added to the agenda for discussion for the next meeting.

- Scott Edwards to confirm if there are speed limits
- Staff to inquire about the possibility of the developer getting “Watch for Children” signs.
- Scott Edwards to inquire with the Engineering Department, to see if they are able to come to a meeting to discuss development.

My driveway is [REDACTED] and I have been nearly hit by speeders several times and today I was walking with our [REDACTED] son and dog and was almost hit by a speeder who didn't slow down at the bridge [REDACTED] when another car was coming the other direction at the same time. All 3 of us were as far over to the bridge rail as we could be and I felt the wind. This isn't the only time I have had near misses. I cannot walk on the left hand side of the road when I am walking home from the park facing the traffic as I should because people go way too fast and may not see us as there is a slight bend in the road. What can we do?? Can we please have an increased police presence at this end of Pefferlaw Rd to enforce the speed limit? Can we have the 80 sign moved farther away from the homes and closer to Lakeridge where there are far fewer homes? Can we have signs posted that say "kids at play" or something like that? Kids are always walking along this road where there are NO sidewalks and school will be out soon so they will be out a lot more. There are 14 children/teens (I think) that live east of the small bridge. I am very scared for all of our safety. I should feel safe walking with our [REDACTED] son and dog. We do not have sidewalks at this end. The least the town can do is have police patrol (also the automatic speed limit sign that tells drivers how fast they are going may help. I see them in other places in Georgina) and look at either decreasing the speed limit or at very least move the 80 farther out and start the 40 earlier. It's a matter of moving 2 signs to try and help this issue. Do we need a petition started for any of this to happen?

I look forward to hearing back from you about this very important safety issue.
