- The Committee discussed breaking up the day for the dancers, with 2 stages and 12 routines per stage (over a 4 hour period) dancers would be asked to perform twice.
- Dancers would be required to bring their own music, costumes, props, and equipment.
- Karen McGill offered to draft a letter for Committee member Alicia Lauzon (representative of the York Region Police, Diversity Equity and Inclusion Bureau), who advised she would require a letter requesting approval to attend the event.
- Karen McGill advised the Committee that the Chippewa 'Big Drum' was available for a fee of \$500.00 and that the Chippewa dancers were \$125.00 each.

- Under the heading *Why diversity and inclusion are important:*
 - Where the paragraph refers to the vision of GEDAC. Refer to the purpose which is defined in the Committee's terms of Reference
- Under the heading *How we support diversity and inclusion at the Town of Georgina;*
 - The first paragraph reflects the membership construction of the previous Georgina Equity and Diversity Advisory Committee and should be amended to reflect the current membership construction as per the most up to date terms of reference.
 - The fourth paragraph the last sentence be amended to state "We do not discriminate unfairly on grounds of age, gender – gender identity, race, national or ethnic origin, language, religion, political beliefs, sexual orientation, physical and mental ability.
