Item 6 – Patti White provided an update on behalf of Phil Rose-Donahoe. The Town has awarded the contract and expect to commence work on the asphalt trail section in mid to late May (weather permitting). The ramp section for the beach is out for tender and will close the week of May 1, 2017. Work is expected to start the day after Labour Day for completion in late fall or early winter. The beach area Mobi Mat is being awarded at Council Wednesday and will be installed by Town Staff when the park opens Spring 2018. Lake Drive crossing components will be timed to coincide with total project completion (Spring 2018, with temporary line painting sooner as required).

The Committee would like an explanation why the project won't be done this year. Patti White advised the work will disrupt the use of the beach so work will take place this fall.

The Committee would like to see work done this summer.

The Committee questioned where the asphalt trail goes in the park. Patti White advised the trail runs from the parking lot to the playground to the washrooms.

Phyllis Baines questioned when the surface on the playground will be changed from woodchips to rubber. Patti White will check with Phil Rose-Donahoe.

Item 8 – Ideas have been taken to the committee and there are a lot of ideas coming in. The committee is working on deciding what project to do.

Item 10 – It is unclear when the trailer will be built. It will not be ready for the Music in the Streets event and there is another event on the fair weekend.

Item 11 – The Chamber is not distributing the letter and the sticker. The Town will be distributing the stickers with letter.

Item 16 – Annette Piggott is getting prices for a Hoyer lift and sling. It will cost approximately \$5,000.00 and it will have to go to Council as it is a liability. There may be additional costs for training.

Ideas for accessible seating have been looked at as well. There could be a ramp with a raised platform for viewing added. The hope is to have the renovation completed by fall.

Toby Merker felt this was a great solution for viewing and also suggested lowering the height of one of the windows.

Regional Councillor Naomi Davison would like the Committee to think about some ideas for accessible seating.

Toby Merker advised Young's Harbour and the Leash Free Dog Park are not accessible. The park is gated and the gate is not wide enough to allow accessibility. Toby Merker will be meeting with Andrew Wall.


