

Council Highlights

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Georgina Town Council April 28, 2021

Request to stop up, close and sell portion of a lane located north of Sixth Street

Council received the report regarding the stopping up, closing and conveying of a portion of lane located north of Sixth Street. Council approved the recommendations to deem the portion of the lane as surplus and to approve in principle the stopping up, closing and conveying of the portion of the lane subject to public notice requirements; and should no objection be received, a by-law be passed to authorize the stopping up, closure and sale of the lane north of Sixth Street to an abutting property owner(s) at a minimum rate of approximately \$3.74 per square foot.

Proposed Sale of Town-owned parking lot located east of the Canada Post Corporation building at 202 Church St.

Council received the report respecting the proposed sale of the Town-owned parking lot located east of the Canada Post Corporation building. Council decided to send the report back to staff for additional information on the licensing agreement, the amount of public parking in the area and to determine the value of the property.

Earthworks agreement for Multi-use Recreation Complex (MURC) block and future Garrett Styles Road extension

Council received the report respecting the Earthworks Agreement for the MURC block and future Garrett Styles road extension within the draft plan of subdivision for phase 10 of Simcoe Landing. Council also authorized a by-law allowing the Mayor and Town Clerk to enter into an Earthworks Agreement between Wesrow Estates Inc. and the Town. It is essential the earthworks are completed in a timely manner to facilitate the construction of the MURC.
