Proposed addition to reserve Chippewas of Georgina Island First Nation

Council considered a report presenting requests by the Chippewas of Georgina Island First Nation seeking Council's support of applications made to Indigenous Affairs Canada to add five sites to the existing reserve. The five sites are on the mainland and are generally in the rural area and Virginia. Council adopted a resolution supporting the five applications by the Chippewas of Georgina Island First Nation to Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada indicating that as the applications progress through the process, Council looks forward to any opportunities for mutual collaboration and discussion. A copy of the report and Council's resolution will be sent to Sylvia McCue, Lands Manager the Chippewas of Georgina Island First Nation, Indigenous Services Canada and the Provincial Ministry of Indigenous Affairs for each of the five applications.
