Georgina Town Council Sept. 29, 2021

Application to amend zoning by-law 500

Council received the report and approved the recommendations regarding the application to amend zoning by-law 500. The report provided staff analysis on a proposed zoning by-law Amendment at 20971, 20977, 20979 and 20987 Dalton Rd. in Sutton. The zoning by-law amendment facilitates a proposed expansion to an existing building supply and equipment sales establishment, and associated parking areas, accessory buildings and open storage. The existing on-site wetland and woodland are proposed to be removed, pursuant to the payment of approximately \$150,000 in ecological offsetting funds to the Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority. The off-setting funds will be spent in either of the two subject sub-watersheds where the feature is located. Council resolved to make minor modifications to the proposed zoning by-law and to pass same pending satisfactory progress through the site plan control process.
