Georgina Town Council Feb. 16, 2022

Ontario Water Centre update – Semi-annual report, 2022 work plan and lease agreement Council received the staff report, along with the semi-annual update and the 2022 work plan prepared by the Ontario Water Centre. Given the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Ontario Water Centre was limited in terms of promoting public access to the site. However, it did complete a number of infrastructure improvements including the installation of municipal water and sewers to the property. The centre has an ambitious plan for 2022, building on existing programming, and promoting new activity and visitation to the site. Council also approved the amendment to the lease agreement to extend the date for the fulfillment of the performance criteria as it applies to Parcel C from June 26, 2023 to June 26, 2025.

Georgina Equity and Diversity Advisory Committee shared GEDAC community survey results along with proposed initiatives for 2022

Council received the <u>presentation</u> from the Georgina Equity and Diversity Committee (GEDAC) regarding the results from the community survey. Council approved two proposed initiatives for 2022 which included the purchase and distribution of "Hate has no home here" decals, and the development of cultural foods flyer in collaboration with the Georgina Food Pantry.
